The collies need to have a good expression and look presentable. Many people buy our calendars—we even have international fans!

We prioritize submissions. NCR rescue collies have priority and then other rescue collies or collies of rescuers, volunteers, and donors.

Fifty percent of all sales purchased through <u>our store</u> goes directly to helping NCR collies in need. Calendars are also a great way to showcase the wonderful lives our rescue collies go on to lead in their furever homes.
